

Annexure A – Detailed Import Process

Apply to be an importer (1)

Entity – KEPHIS

Requirements-

1. Cover letter - It should be addressed to the Managing Director giving a short description of the company.
2. Certificate of incorporation/compliance for a local company.
3. Company PIN certificate
4. 2 copies of ID cards/passport

Timeframe – 10 days to point 2

Note – The application can be submitted physically or sent via e-mail to the headquarters or regional offices. However, applications submitted to regional offices take longer to process as they are forwarded to the headquarters.

REGISTER AS AN IMPORTER

Obtain user credentials (6)

Pay for quarantine facility audit for propagation materials

Entity – KEPHIS

Notes – If the trader intends to import plant propagation materials e.g. flower cuttings, they will be required to pay for the quarantine facility audit.

Timeframe – 3 days

Request for training on import certification system (3)

Entity – KEPHIS Plant Inspection unit

Notes – Training is scheduled every Monday from 9:00 a.m. - 11:00 a.m. except on public holidays.

Quarantine facility audit for propagation materials

Entity – KEPHIS

Requirements –

1. List of requirements for open quarantine facilities. The quarantine facility should be located in an isolated site and fulfil the requirements in the checklist which include operation records, be well guarded and hygienic.
2. Physical presence of the importer and technical personnel of the facility during the audit.

Note - The quarantine facility audit report is valid for three months.

Cost – KSh 75,000

Timeframe – 5 days

Note - The certificate of registration is valid for one calendar year. Failure to renew the certificate for two consecutive years leads to loss of status as a registered seed merchant and will require a fresh application to be made as a new applicant.

Entity - KEPHIS

Requirements:

All:

1. Seed handling experience of the staff; they are expected to have a background and knowledge on seeds.
2. Physical presence of the owner or technical personal of the seed store.

For production category:

1. Contract - Evidence of contractual agreements with the recruited growers.
2. Land - Adequate land and equipment to handle the basic seeds. The applicant should also provide the source of starter or basic seed used.

For processing category:

1. Machinery and equipment for processing seeds.

For marketing category:

1. Seed store - Facility where the seeds will be stored should be a permanent structure with pallets, well aerated and free from rodents.

Note - The invoice will detail the fees to be charged for each seed variety.

Timeframe – The waiting time until the National Performance Trials Committee meeting, varies from 4 to 5 months depending on the species; during this time, the seeds will be planted, analysed and tested, before results of DUS testing are released in form of a report, in the minutes of the NVRC meeting.

Note - Once payment is made and processed, the applicant will be notified of a National Performance Trials Committee meeting, where six crop specialists will attend on behalf of all other breeders.

Entity – KEPHIS

Requirements – Physical presence of breeder

Note - Breeders, who must be present at the meeting to name the new seed variety, will receive a copy of the National Variety Release Committee meeting minutes at the meeting. The minutes will contain the DUS test report. Within 21 days of the NVRC meeting, a gazette notice will be published listing all the new varieties that have been cleared for release into the Kenyan market for breeders to produce. The NVRC meeting is held once a year.

Note - The applicant will be notified via e-mail to attend the National Variety Release Committee meeting.

Note - The seed crop breeders will receive a copy of the NPT test report from KEPHIS. The report is sent via email.

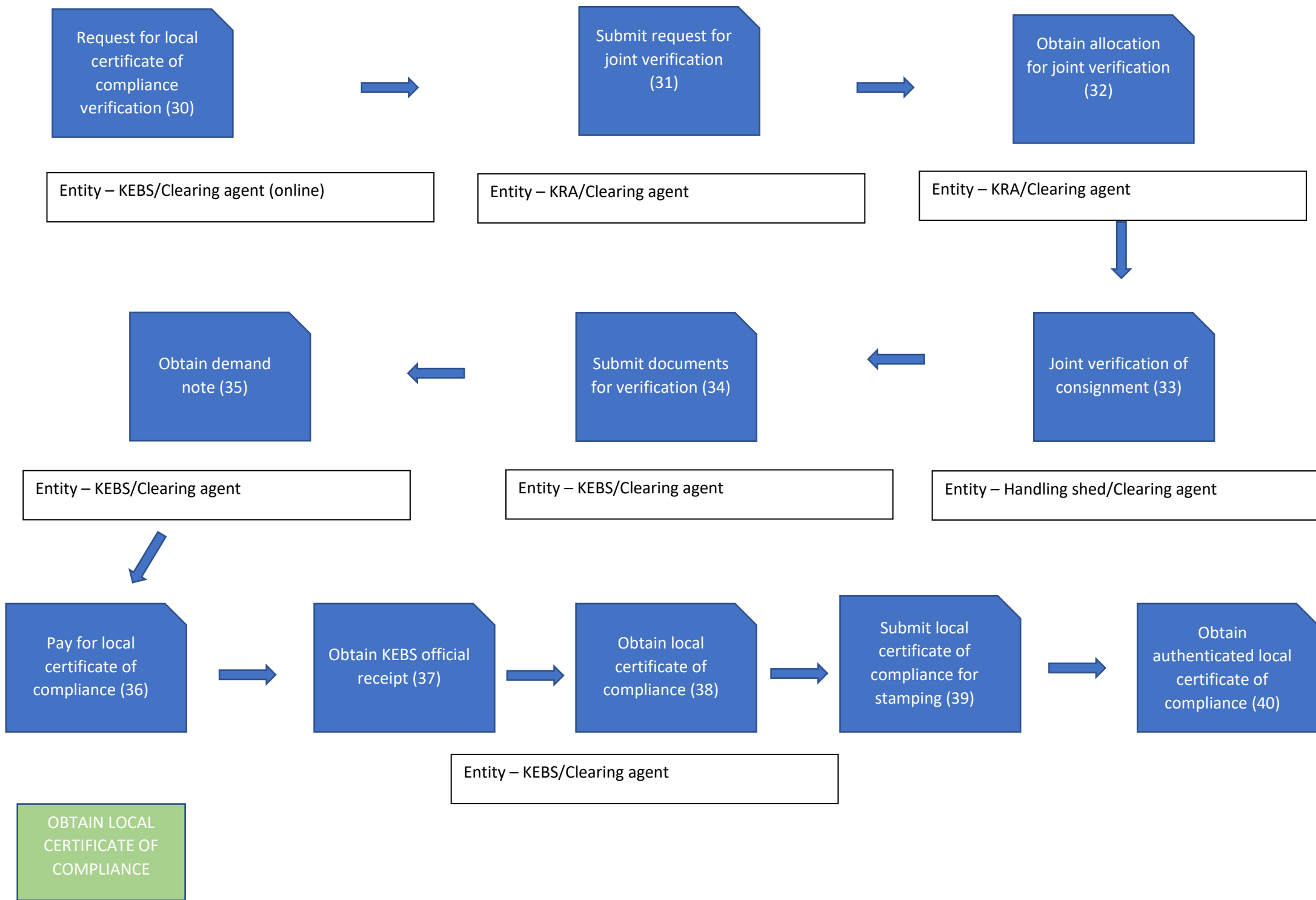

Note - The application form must be filled and submitted in Microsoft excel format. The certificate of conformity (COC) number, import declaration form (IDF) number, unique consignment reference (UCR) number and customs entry number will be required.

Traders are advised to apply for the ISM sticker once the goods have arrived, and the customs entry has been verified and passed by Kenya Revenue Authority (KRA).

Requirements –

1. Plant import permit/clearance entry
2. Phytosanitary certificate
3. Notice to import - Form SR14
4. ISTA (International Seed Testing Association) certificate
5. Invoice

Note - If the seeds were not grown in the country of export, a copy of a phytosanitary certificate will be required from the country of origin of the seed, as well as an original phytosanitary certificate from the country of export.

Entity – KEPHIS

Requirements –

1. Physical presence of the clearing agent.
2. Consignment to be imported

Timeframe – 1 Hour

Note - KEPHIS will stamp the customs entry to indicate clearance and retain the original Plant Import Permit, ISTA certificate and phytosanitary certificate(s).

If the consignment does not meet the phytosanitary requirements, it can be treated, destroyed or shipped back to the country of origin at the expense of the importer.

The KEPHIS inspector will also draw samples of seeds from the consignment, as per the ISTA regulations, chapter 2, for analysis prior to issuance of a seed testing certificate. This can take up to two weeks.

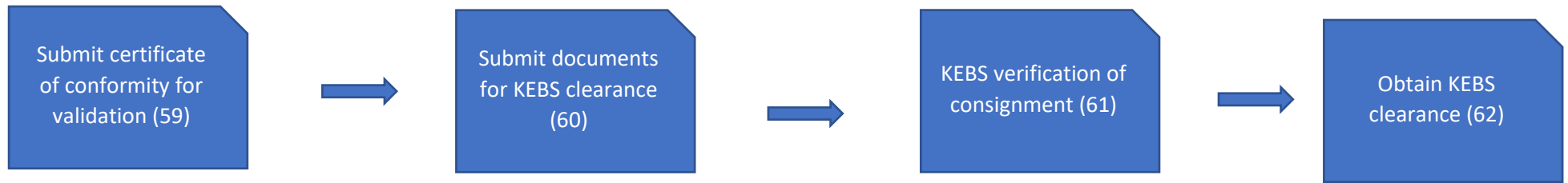
