ASTA is working closely with U.S. Embassies and national seed associations in countries critical for counter seasonal production to determine travel requirements. <sup>\*</sup>The Chilean Seed Association ANPROS reports Chilean companies have been successful in requesting foreign visitor travel exemptions to perform essential agriculture services in country. The application process is best initiated by the company in Chile, not the foreign traveler. Applications are reviewed by the Ministry of Agriculture and Foreign Ministry. Approval takes between 7-10 days for trips occuring wihtin 90 days. Travelers with the exemption approval may enter Chile with a negative PCR test and are not required to qurantine.
