# How do I use a QR Code?

Scattered throughout the program and around the Seed Expo, you will find QR codes, which can be read by the camera on many mobile devices (with the right software installed).

# Follow these installation instructions:

#### Installation on Android

- 1. Open the "Market" application from the Android home screen
- 2. Press the search button on the Android keyboard and enter "zxing." Press [ENTER] to search.
- 3. Touch the application named "Barcode Scanner."
- 4. Press the Install button.
- You will be prompted that the device requires elevated access to your device. Press the OK button to confirm.
- Once the application is downloaded and installed, the scanner can be launched by selecting "Barcode Scanner" from the home screen.

What's a QR Code? A quick response code is a type of matrix or twodimensional code. The code consists of black modules arranged in a square pattern on a white background. This code, first used by the automotive industry, became popular because of its fast readability and comparatively large storage capacity.

#### Installation on Blackberry

The "BlackBerry App World" application can natively scan QR codes and load any recognizable Web URLs on its browser.

#### Installation on iPhone and iTouch

- 1. Open the "App Store" application from the home screen

- 3. Locate the application named "Barcodes" by Christian Brunschen.
- Touch the "Free" icon at the top of the screen. It will change to an "Install" icon.
- 5. Touch the "Install" icon that just appeared.
- 6. Enter your iTunes password when prompted
- Once the application is downloaded and installed, the scanner can be launched by selecting "Barcodes" from the home screen.
